

GOVERNMENT

Marilyn has already worked to make government more accessible, and she has some new ideas to continue the progress she has made.

1. Remove the ability of elected public officials and high level public managers to profit from their service.

- Establish a two-year period before they can go to work for any business they regulated.
- Create a two-year cooling off period before they can lobby the body they served in or worked for.



2. Make the state's budget and checkbook available for everyone to see.

- Require by law that the state budget be placed on an open website where everyone can easily search for information on spending.
- Create a second website where the state's checkbook is posted in real time so anyone who is interested can see who is getting paid for what.

3. Open more information about candidates for public office and do it sooner.

- Change the Financial Disclosure Form to require the listing of a candidate's employer and the candidate's financial holdings including partnerships.
- Require that all campaign contributions and expenditures be posted online with the Secretary of State within 72 hours of receipt or expenditure.
